

## WERE YOU A QUÉBEC BEEKEEPER BETWEEN JANUARY 1, 2006 AND FEBRUARY 20, 2018?

If so, a class action might affect your legal rights.



The Superior Court of Québec authorized a class action concerning the alleged effects of neonicotinoid pesticides on honeybee colonies. The class action seeks to recover financial damages or losses suffered by beekeepers in Quebec who own or owned honey bees, including queen bees, between January 1, 2006 and February 20, 2018, which were located in, and within 11,27 km (7 miles) of an area zoned for agricultural use (the "Class").
