

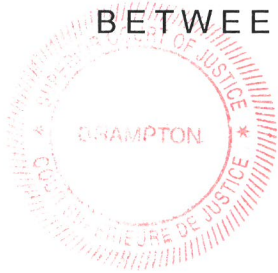

ORDER

THIS MOTION, made by the plaintiffs for production of information from the defendant the Toronto Institute for Reproductive Medicine Inc. was heard this day by Telephone Case Conference.

ON BEING ADVISED that the defendant Chart Industries consents to the Order and that the defendants The Toronto Institute for Reproductive Medicine Inc. (the "Clinic"), ReProMed Ltd. and Dr. Alfonso Del Valle do not oppose the relief sought,

THIS COURT ORDERS:

1. The Clinic shall provide the following information to all counsel, relating to the putative class members:

(a) The age and gender of each patient as of May 22, 2018.

- (b) To advise whether any of the patients were known to have, as of May 22, 2018, a medical condition which could affect their ability to reproduce the reproductive material which was lost.
- (c) To advise whether any of the patients experienced any material complication as a result of undergoing an IVF cycle.
- (d) To the extent a donor was required by any of the patients, indicate whether, to the Clinic's employees' knowledge, the same donor was available for an additional cycle as of June 2018.
- (e) The number of patients who have undergone an additional IVF cycle or egg retrieval since May 22, 2018.
- (f) The number of patients who have agreed to undergo an additional IVF cycle or egg retrieval at the Clinic but have not done so to date.
- (g) For each patient, indicate the number of eggs retrieved and the number of embryos created as a result of additional treatment received at the Clinic since May 22, 2018, where applicable.
- (h) For each patient who has undergone an additional IVF cycle, indicate the grade of the embryos lost in May 2018 and the grade of embryos subsequently created.
