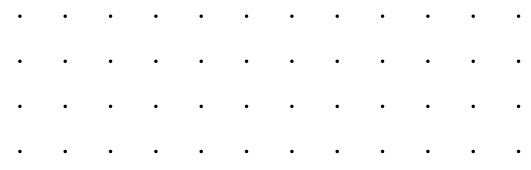
As a personal injury lawyer, Dagmara assists injured individuals and their families in all aspects of their injury claim. She brings expertise and compassion to each claim.
