Karim's practice is essentially concentrated in the areas of civil and commercial litigation and class actions. He is also a certified mediator.

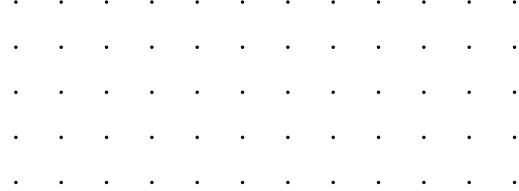
